






In this version, a few design changes were made during evaluation phase:

a.

Some changes were made to the seating area 'Peace under Sky': -

- a wall was installed between this arched space to create a more covered (roofed) space for rainy, windy, and sunny days.
- a small bench was added at the end of the arched bench to offer more seating space to users and let them look at each other easily while talking.
- instead of one trash can, three trash cans (recycling bins) were installed for different types of trash (supporting recycling system).

b.

In the area of 'Sense of Sea', a palm-shaped spinner was installed near the sand table. Also, a turtle-shaped element was installed near the sand the table which let small children easily climb to access the sand table and sit on that for playing. The palm and turtle make the area more beautiful and enjoyable to use.


